Metered Parking on Thanksgiving and Thanksgiving Friday

On Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 27, 2008, all parking at metered spaces on-street in the downtown and University of Kentucky areas will be free. The meters will still operate, but parkers are not required to pay.

On Friday, the day after Thanksgiving Day, November 28, 2008, on-street parking will resume its normal schedule. Parkers will be required to pay the meters in order to park at the designated spaces on the street. Parking violations will be enforced on a normal basis.

The Lexington and Fayette County Parking Authority was created by ordinance (ARTICLE XIII Sec. 2-178, Res. No. 300-80, § 1, 10-16-80; Ord. No. 329-2005, § 1, 12-13-05) in December 2005, with the five-member board appointed in June 2006.
