Parking Authority Begins Online Parking Ticket Payments

LEXINGTON, KY September 15, 2008 – In a continuing effort to enhance the Lexington Parking Program, the Lexington and Fayette County Parking Authority (LFCPA) now has made paying parking tickets easier.

Parking tickets and any late fees can be paid online through the LFCPA website at <http://www.lexpark.org/pay-citation.html>. Individuals may view the citations they owe and select those they wish to pay. A convenience fee of \$2.50 is charged for the payment.

The Authority begins its booting program on September 22, 2008, so anyone with outstanding unpaid citations is encouraged to pay before that date.

The Lexington and Fayette County Parking Authority was created by ordinance (ARTICLE XIII Sec. 2-178, Res. No. 300-80, § 1, 10-16-80; Ord. No. 329-2005, § 1, 12-13-05) in December 2005, with the five-member board appointed in June 2006.
